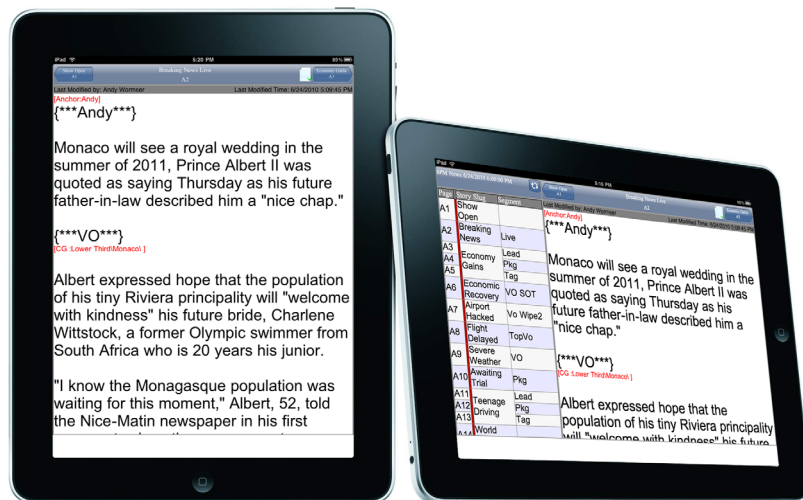


ENPS TABLET STORY VIEWER
